Getting to Alma

The town of Alma, population about 10,000, is located in the center of Michigan's lower peninsula — an hour north of Lansing, the state capital; an hour and a half northeast of Grand Rapids; two hours from the northwest suburbs of Detroit; and only two hours from the best of Michigan's beaches and ski areas. The College's beautiful and convenient 125-acre campus is located in a residential neighborhood, a block and a half from nearby downtown shops and attractions.

Arriving by Car

From the North: Take US-127 to Alma, 17 miles south of Mt. Pleasant. Take the first Alma exit, which is Business 127. At the fourth light on Business 127 (also called Wright Avenue), turn right onto Superior Street. The College is on your right.

From the South: Take US-127 north, about 48 miles from Lansing, to the Edmore exit (second exit past the Alma exit) to M-46 west and turn left. At the first light, turn left onto Business 127 (also called Alger Road). Continue on to Wright Avenue to the third light and turn right onto Superior Street. The College is on your right.

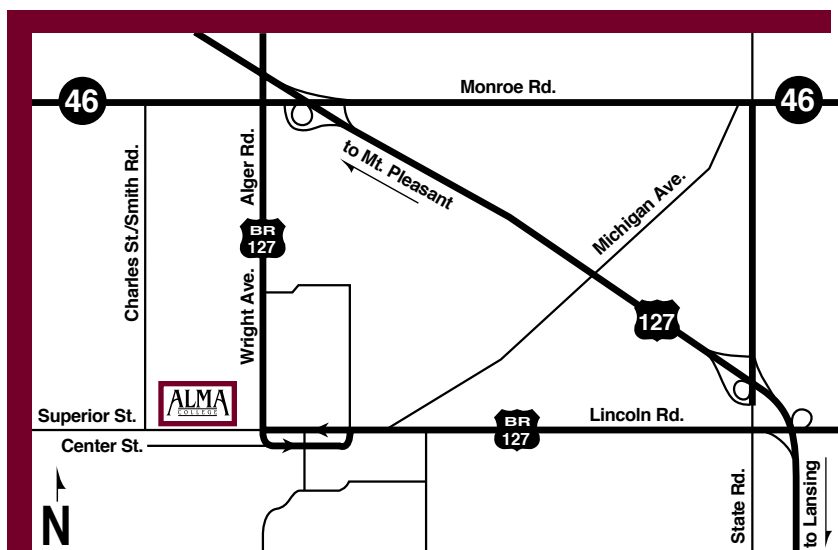
From the West: Take M-46 east from US-131, about 40 miles. Turn right on Business 127. At the third light on Business 127 (also called Wright Avenue), turn right onto Superior Street. The College is on your right.



From the East: Take M-46 west from Saginaw, about 35 miles. Turn left on Business 127. At the third light on Business 127 (also called Wright Avenue), turn right onto Superior Street. The College is on your right.

Arriving by Plane or Train

Alma College is easily reached by airplane with service through Capital City Airport in Lansing or MBS International Airport in Saginaw. Amtrak serves Lansing as well. The admissions staff will gladly assist you in arranging for transportation to and from your arrival point.
